Since joining Everbridge, I have led the company's positioning on the sustainability and disaster reduction agenda internationally. After almost three years, Everbridge is now a strong advocate of disaster risk reduction through several fora: at the UN (UNDRR, ITU, World Bank), and through partnerships with other private sectors members, such as Skyline Partners for parametric insurances.

As the leading tech company for digitization of critical event management and critical event communication software and services, we channel our know-how and experience through crucial initiatives and partnerships. I have been a strong advocate of the Early Warning for All initiative, on which we are currently working with ITU, many private sector enterprises (Howden), and academia (Johns Hopkins SAIS Europe and University College London). I revamped our membership in ARISE after years of inactivity. I launched, in partnership with the Business Development team, the Insurance Backed Risk Facility (IBRF), a btb financial vehicle, that brings together parametric calculators, insurers, technology, and response mechanisms for disaster reduction and response.

Outside Everbridge, I have been collaborating with the City of Imola to bring the city into the UN Making Cities Resilient 2030, and drafted EU projects based on ESG+R.
