## BIOGRAPHY

Henry Ee is the Founder and Managing Director of Business Continuity Planning Asia (BCP Asia).

With more than 25 years of Business Continuity, IT-Disaster Recovery and Crisis Management experience, Henry has undertaken over 500 projects in advisory and training roles, spanning across Asia Pacific, including Singapore, Malaysia, Brunei, Indonesia, Philippines, Sri Lanka, Hong Kong, Macau, Saudi Arabia, Australia, China and Thailand; covering a wide span of industries from Healthcare, Banking & Finance, Logistics, Manufacturing, Telecommunication, Transportation, Educational to Public Sector.

Henry has also trained and guided over 5000 professionals across Asia, some of them going on to attain their professional BCM certification.

Before starting the company in year 2000, he gained practical experience as an end-user through senior position appointments as Regional BCP Manager in 2 international banks, ABN AMRO and JP Morgan Chase, where he rolled out comprehensive regional BCP programs and rigorous trainings & exercises. In the course of his career, Henry successfully activated the recovery plans for various scenarios such as strikes, Y2K, 911, SARS and H1N1. This is where he developed his passion in the areas of Business Continuity and Resilience.

The first Asian to be elected to the Board of BCI (UK), Henry was later awarded with the Lifetime Achievement Award by BCI in 2010. He also contributed to the development of standards since 2007, as member of the Standards Committee for SS540:2008 Singapore BCM Standard, BS25999, SS507 Singapore IT-DR standard, ISO22301, BC standard development for ASIS (US) and China BCM standard. Most recently, Henry served as the Technical Expert for Business Continuity/Resilience on the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) on the ISO22301:2019 review. He is also part of the team in drafting the updated Pandemic guide published by Enterprise Singapore.
